Illinois Prairie Path and Great Western Trail Parking

At the November 7, 2005 Transportation and Safety Committee meeting, the Committee directed staff to investigate all of the trail crossings for adequate sight distance. Staff checked all crossings on three different days, alternating mornings and afternoons. The results are attached. Only vehicles that were parked within 100 feet of a crossing were recorded.

DuPage County has maintained a 40 foot sight triangle from the sidewalk. This is the result of the Village working with the County to improve sight distances at all their crossings. This was accomplished a few years ago and recently this summer, the County cut back vegetation from their intersections.

The following is a list of all trail crossings, findings and staff recommendations:
