**ORDINANCE NO. 7574**

**AN ORDINANCE  
AMENDING TITLE XI, CHAPTER 112, SECTION 112.24  
OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE  
IN REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND  
BIRTH DEFECT AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SIGNAGE**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** That Title XI, Chapter 112, Section 112.24 of the Lombard Village Code is amended by adding a new subsection (D) thereto, which shall read in its entirety as follows:

“(D) All licensees under this Chapter 112 shall post a sign, in plain view in the licensed premises, relative to alcoholic beverages and birth defects, and substance abuse assistance, as required by and in compliance with 235 ILCS 5/6-24a(b). Said sign may be obtained from the Village or the Illinois Liquor Control Commission.”

**SECTION 2:** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
