

ORDINANCE NO. 5718

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 5516, ADOPTED JULY 22, 2004, IN REGARD TO THE PAVING AND IMPROVING OF WEST ROAD, FROM WOODLAND AVENUE TO ST. CHARLES ROAD (SPECIAL ASSESSMENT NO. 213B)

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That in light of the fact that the Village of Lombard was able to sell bonds to finance this improvement at an interest rate of less than nine percent (9%), Section 6 of Ordinance No. 5516, adopted July 22, 2004, is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"SECTION 6: The aggregate amount herein ordered to be assessed and each individual assessment shall be divided into fifteen (15) installments which shall bear interest at the rate of 5.0385% until paid, all in the manner and in accordance with the provisions of 65 ILCS 5/9-2-1 through 5/9-2-144, as supplemented by the provisions of 50 ILCS 460/1 through 460/60, which the Village hereby elects to be applicable to this Special Assessment."

SECTION 2: That all other provisions of Ordinance No. 5516, adopted July 22, 2004, shall remain in full force and effect.
