

ORDINANCE NO. 6037

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112
OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO
ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND THE CLASS "T" LIQUOR LICENSE CATEGORY**

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.12(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the language therein relative to the Class "T" liquor license to read in its entirety as follows:

"Class "T-I" Beer and wine only served at no charge, but limited in number of drinks, for consumption by patrons of a hotel on the premises of a hotel without a restaurant (manager's reception). Beer and wine only packaged sales to patrons of the hotel shall also be allowed provided all beer and wine on display for sale shall be kept in a locked display case with only the cashier being able to unlock said display case. If the hotel currently has a Class "O" liquor license, said hotel need not also obtain a Class "T-I" liquor license.

Class "T-II" Beer and wine only served at no charge, but limited in number of drinks, for consumption by patrons of a hotel on the premises of a hotel without a restaurant (manager's reception). Beer and wine only packaged sales to patrons of the hotel shall also be allowed provided all beer and wine on display for sale shall be kept in a locked display case with only the cashier being able to unlock said display case. Beer and wine only may also be sold to patrons of the hotel for consumption on the premises of the hotel from a managed bar area. If the hotel currently has a Class "O" liquor license, said hotel need not also obtain a Class "T-II" liquor license."

SECTION 2: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the language therein relative to the Class “T” liquor license to read in its entirety as follows:

“Class “T-I” - 1
Class “T-II” - 1”

SECTION 3: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.14(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the language therein relative to the Class “T” liquor license to read in its entirety as follows:

“Class “T-I” - \$500
Class “T-II” - \$1,000”

SECTION 4: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.40(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the reference therein to “all Class A/B-I, A/B-II, A/B-III, C, D, E-I, E-II, I, K, L, M, O, R, T, X and Z liquor license holders,” to read, “all Class A/B-I, A/B-II, A/B-III, C, D, E-I, E-II, I, K, L, M, O, R, T-I, T-II, X and Z liquor license holders.”

SECTION 5: That the current Class “T” liquor license issued to Residence Inn by Marriott LLC, operating the business commonly known as Residence Inn, located at 2001 South Highland Avenue, Lombard, is hereby changed to a Class “T-I” liquor license, as authorized in Section 2 above.

SECTION 6: That the Class “T-II” liquor license, referenced in Section 2 above, reflects the issuance of a Class “T-II” liquor license to Lombard Inn & Suites, Inc. operating the business commonly known as Fairfield Inn & Suites, located at 645 West North Avenue, Lombard.

SECTION 7: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
