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

Resident Engineering

Attached please find a contract, resolution and fee schedule for resident engineering services for the Great Western Trail Bridges project.

This selection was made from the current Resident Engineering Short List. The short list is comprised of six firms. The proposal was sent to Six (6) firms. The design firm, Bollinger Lach & Associates was not on the short list. Six (6) firms responded to the request for proposal. Upon review, it was determined that Thomas Engineering Group LLC, is the most qualified firm to serve as resident engineer for this project.

Thomas Engineering Group, LLC satisfactorily performed Resident Engineering for the St. Charles Road Watermain Replacement and N. Main Street LAPP projects.

The scope and fee were negotiated with Thomas Engineering and agreed to by both parties. The not-to-exceed fee for resident engineering services is \$911,722.01. 60% of the resident engineering associated with the railroad grade separation will be funded by the Grade Crossing Protection Fund, currently estimated at \$247,785.06.

Please present this agreement and resolution to the President and Board of Trustees for their review and approval at the next meeting, June 16, 2011. If approved, please return two original signed copies to Public Works-Engineering for further processing.
