On Monday, April 5, 2010, bids were opened for the IT - HVAC System Replacement Project. Bid specifications were sent to or picked up by six (6) contractors, resulting in five (5) bidders responding who met Village specifications. The bid results are as follows:

The bids came in over budget but after reviewing the projects that were approved in the FY 2010 Capital Improvements Budget we have been able to find the \$16,887.00 needed to accomplish this project. The Public Works Department is recommending that KCW Environmental Conditioning, Inc. be awarded a contract for the IT-HVAC System Replacement Project in an amount not to exceed \$65,387.00.
