Subject: Parking Signage Change

In the general area from St. Charles Rd. to Windsor Ave. and Main St. to Craig Pl. The Village has 5 different sign types that are due to be replaced (see attached map – Existing Signage). I reviewed this area and contacted Dane Cuny, Deputy Chief for his input to standardize all the parking in this area. Dane had no problem with the change. Attached is a "Proposed Signage" map for your review. This area would have 2 sign types "No Parking" and "1 Hour, 7am-10am, Except Sunday and Holidays". The "1 Hour, 7am-10am, Except Sunday and Holidays" sign is the standard sign used to deter commuters from parking, yet allow residents to park on the street.

I would recommend standardizing the signage as proposed on the map.
