Subject: Requested Relocation of No Parking on the West Side of Garfield Street between Roosevelt Road and 13<sup>th</sup> Street to the East Side

Staff has discovered conflicting information in Schedule VII and Schedule X of the Traffic Code. Specifically, parking is prohibited at all times on the West Side of Garfield Street (Schedule VII) between Roosevelt Road and 13<sup>th</sup> Street and parking is regulated to one hour between 9 am and 5 pm (Schedule X) in the same location.

A review of the situation revealed adequate off-street parking is provided for businesses located on the east side of Garfield Street and parking would best be restricted to one side of the road for adequate traffic flow. Therefore, staff recommends relocating the No Parking Zone from the west side of Garfield Street between Roosevelt Road and 13<sup>th</sup> Street to the east side as follows:

SCHEDULE VII – PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS		
In accordance with Section 10-13-6 and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall, at any time, park a vehicle upon any of the following streets or parts of streets:		
Name of Street	From	To
<b>DELETE:</b> Garfield St., west side	Roosevelt Rd.	13 <sup>th</sup> St.
<b>ADD:</b> Garfield St., east side	Roosevelt Rd.	13 <sup>th</sup> St.
