Subject: Awarding Tree Trimming Contract

On May 14, 2004, Bid Documents for the Village contract **PWO 0515**, *Parkway Tree Trimming* were sent to 14 local tree care companies. The bid opening was held on May 24th with five (5) bids being received. I have attached the Bid Tabulation sheet.

I would recommend awarding the contract to *The Care of Trees* for one year for an amount of \$48,104.00 which is \$8,104.00 over what the Village Board has approved this fiscal year for parkway tree trimming. Actual costs are based on a *per tree* basis determined by the diameter of individual trees. For 36,305.50, *The Care of Trees* would be able to trim about 1,250 trees in the northwest quarter of the village this winter. This area has not been trimmed since 1996 and the majority of the trees have very low branches.

Per our discussion in April, we are attempting to find options of reducing the number of trees trimmed by in-house staff. In this year's trimming specifications, we added the category of *Demand Pruning* - the trimming of trees on an "individual tree" basis. For \$11,798.50, *The Care of Trees* will be able to trim additional 250 (the average number of tree trimming service requests per year) trees throughout the fiscal year thus reducing the number of trees trimmed by in-house staff and the potential for any additional injuries.

Please present this item to the Board of Trustees at the June 3, 2004 meeting for their approval.
