Please find attached an Ordinance Amending Title 11, Chapter 119 of the Lombard Village Code in regard to food handler licenses. This Ordinance has been drafted to address (BYOB) Bring Your Own Bottle Prohibition relative to food handlers without a liquor license.

Section 119.05 clearly prohibits allowing alcoholic liquor to be consumed upon the licensed premises, regardless if the alcohol is provided by the food handler or customer of the food handler unless such business has a valid liquor license.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING  
TITLE 11, CHAPTER 119 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE  
IN REGARD TO FOOD HANDLER LICENSES**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** That Title 11, Chapter 119 of the Lombard Village Code is hereby amended by adding a new Section 119.05 thereto, which shall read in its entirety as follows:

“§ 119.05 ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR SERVICE LIMITATION.

It shall be unlawful for any food handler that is licensed, pursuant to Section 119.02 above, to allow alcoholic liquor to be consumed upon the licensed premises, regardless of whether such alcoholic liquor is provided by the food handler or provided by the customer of the food handler, unless the food handler also has a valid liquor license issued by the Village pursuant to Chapter 112 of this Code.”

**SECTION 2:** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
