Subject: Glenbard East student named a Golden Apple Scholar

Congratulations to Glenbard East High School student Timothy Sullivan, who has been selected to be among the 100 members of the Golden Apple Scholars of Illinois Class of 2011.

Any Illinois high school student who is interested in a teaching career is eligible for the Golden Apple Scholars of Illinois program.

Each year, Golden Apple chooses as many as 100 high school and college students from schools and universities throughout Illinois. Golden Apple Award-winning teachers choose finalists to be interviewed and select the scholars.

Golden Apple Scholars must earn a bachelor's degree from one of 53 Illinois universities that participate in the program, obtain Illinois teacher certification, and teach for five years in an Illinois school of need. Scholars also must meet GPA requirements and participate in a summer institute. All Golden Apple Scholars receive tuition assistance, paid directly to the scholar's undergraduate institution.

Sullivan will be honored during a reception celebrating the Class of 2011 Scholars on Saturday, April 9, at DePaul University.
