Pleasant Lane One-Way Streets Modification

The Public Safety and Transportation Committee reviewed a request to fully convert streets adjacent to the Pleasant Lane Elementary School into one-way streets on school days. School representatives cited the large amount of vehicle pickup and dropoff congestion for this modification. The existing one-way streets from 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. on school days are listed below.

- Berkshire Ave (eastbound travel only between Main St and Charlotte St)
- Pleasant Ave (westbound travel only between Charlotte St and Main St)

Letter notifications were sent to affected residences, and no comments were received. This modification anticipates improving pedestrian safety and traffic flow around the school. Streets would be one-way from 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. on school days as shown below.

- Berkshire Ave (eastbound travel only between Main St and Garfield St)
- Pleasant Ave (westbound travel only between Garfield St and Main St)

During the June 6, 2016 meeting, the Public Safety and Transportation Committee voted to recommend the street modifications in accordance with staff recommendation.

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Public Safety and Transportation Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Schedule VI entitled "ONE-WAY STREETS" of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) is amended to modify the following restrictions:

"Berkshire Ave., from Main St. to Charlotte St. Between 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on school days, East direction of travel" to "Berkshire Ave from Main St to Garfield St between 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on school days, East direction of travel."

"Pleasant Lane from Charlotte to Main Street, West direction of travel" to "Pleasant Ln from Garfield St to Main St between 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on days on school days, West direction of travel."

Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication in pamphlet form and the posting of appropriate signs as provided by law.
