Liquor License Request**

Back in 2017, Village staff received a formal application requesting a Class “A/B-II” liquor license from Anthony’s Coal Fired Pizza of Lombard LLC d/b/a Anthony’s Coal Fired Pizza located at 783 E. Butterfield Road which would allow alcoholic beverages served as an adjunct to food service with no package sales allowed. This request was to be considered at the November 16, 2017 Village Board meeting. As you will recall, the day of the November 16, 2017 Village Board meeting, the requester withdrew their liquor license request due to changes made to the design and layout of the restaurant which resulted in a delayed opening date.

A representative of Anthony’s Coal Fired Pizza of Lombard LLC has notified staff that they are now ready to move forward with their liquor license request as their targeted opening date is June 29, 2018. Attached is an ordinance increasing the number of entries in the Class “A/B-II” liquor license category by one, effective June 1, 2018, and issuing a liquor license to Anthony’s Coal Fired Pizza of Lombard LLC d/b/a Anthony’s Coal Fired Pizza.

The applicant is requesting a waiver of first reading due to the Board’s summer schedule and to accommodate their anticipated opening date.

Anthony's Coal Fired Pizza – 783 E. Butterfield Rd.

The Village has received a request for a Class "A/B-II" liquor license from Anthony's Coal Fired Pizza of Lombard LLC d/b/a Anthony's Coal Fired Pizza located at 783 E. Butterfield Road which would allow alcoholic beverages served as an adjunct to food service with no package sales allowed.

Anthony's Coal Fired Pizza is currently under construction and anticipating a December opening. They will be a full-service restaurant and bar focusing on traditional and specialty made-to-order pizzas as well as other authentic recipes. They currently have over 60 locations nationwide and the Lombard location is the second of several planned for the Chicagoland market.

Attached is an ordinance increasing the Class "A/B-II" liquor license category by one, effective December 1, 2017, and issuing a liquor license to Anthony's Coal Fired Pizza of Lombard LLC d/b/a Anthony's Coal Fired Pizza.

ORDINANCE \_\_\_\_\_

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112,  
SECTION 112.13(A) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN  
REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES  
OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS** as follows:

Section 1: That, effective June 1, 2018, Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class "A/B-II" liquor license, contained therein, to read as follows:

Class "A/B-II" - 9

This increase in Class "A/B-II" liquor licenses reflects the issuance of a Class "A/B-II" liquor license to Anthony's Coal Fired Pizza of Lombard LLC who will be operating the business commonly known as Anthony's Coal Fired Pizza located at 783 E. Butterfield Road, Lombard.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
