Subject: 2017 Traffic Signal Modernization Program– Construction Contract

To address deficiencies in the Village traffic signal network, the current Capital Improvement Program has a Traffic Signal Modernization Program that began in 2016 through 2020. It will repair and upgrade twenty-four intersections to battery backup systems, LED signal heads, and ADA compliant push buttons and pedestrian countdown timers. In addition, the program will create a more resilient signal network, save energy costs to the Village through energy efficient LED technologies, and promote a triple bottom line project approach. The 2017 program will complete or upgrade nine intersections along Main Street and St. Charles Road.

Instead of a standard Village bid project, Village staff collaborated with DuPage County (County) to produce a joint bid for this project. This produced greater material quantities with the potential of lower bid prices, and the intent was to award the contract based on lowest total bid amount. The lowest total responsible bidder was Meade, Inc., while H&H Electric Company was lowest on Village of Lombard specific quantities. Since the project was advertised through the County, the Village contract is using a publically bid procedure, and below is a fiscal total cost summary of the program.

Work will be performed and completed within 50 working days from the date of issuing the Notice to Proceed. Payments to the Contractor will be based on the actual work performed at the awarded contract unit prices. The Engineering Division recommends awarding this contract to Meade, Inc., in the amount of \$101,046.51, that is under project estimate and project budget.

Please present this item to the President and Board of Trustees for their review and approval at their regular meeting on March 16, 2017. If approved, please return the executed copies of the contract and bond to PW Engineering for further processing.

CONTRACT DOCUMENT NUMBER ST-15-06-17

This agreement is made this 16th day of March, 2017, between and shall be binding upon the Village of Lombard, an Illinois municipal corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "Village") and Meade, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor") and their respective successors.

Witnessed, that in consideration of the mutual promises of the parties delineated in the Contract Documents, the Contractor agrees to perform the services and the Village agrees to pay for the following services as set forth in the Contract Documents:

Complete and upgrade nine intersections to LED signal heads, ADA compliant push buttons, pedestrian countdown timers, and battery backup systems.

1. This contract shall embrace and include all of the applicable Contract Documents listed below as if attached hereto or repeated herein:
 - a. Contract Document Number 17-TSUPG-02-GM for DuPage County Division of Transportation, consisting of the following:
 - i) Cover Sheet
 - ii) Table of Contents
 - iii) General Provisions
 - iv) Special Provisions
 - v) Standard Drawings
 - vi) Traffic Signal Special Provisions
 - b. The Contractor's Bid Proposal Dated: February 14, 2017
 - c. Required Performance and Payment Bonds and Certificate(s) of Insurance
2. The Village agrees to pay, and the Contractor agrees to accept as full payment the amount as shown on the Contractor's Bid Proposal, which is made a part hereof, subject to such additions and deletions as agreed to by the parties hereto.
3. The Contractor shall commence work under this Contract upon written Notice to Proceed from the Village. Time is of the essence in regard to this Contract, and the Contractor agrees to achieve completion within the time permitted by all proper and appropriate means including working overtime without additional compensation.
4. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 5 of the Mechanics' Lien Act of Illinois, prior to making any payment to the Contractor under this Contract, the Village demands that the Contractor furnish a written statement of the names of all parties furnishing labor and/or materials under this Contract and the amounts due or to become due each. This statement must be made under oath or be verified by affidavit. The Village shall

not issue final payment nor shall any retained percentage become due until releases and waivers of lien have been supplied as the Village designates.

- 5. This Contract represents the entire agreement between the parties and may not be modified without the written approval of both parties.

CONTRACT BOND

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we Meade, Inc., a company organized under the laws of the State of _____ and licensed to do business in the State of Illinois as Principal and _____, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of _____, with authority to do business in the State of Illinois, as Surety, are now held and firmly bound unto the Village of Lombard, State of Illinois in the penal sum of _____ dollars (\$ _____) lawful money of the United States, well and truly to be paid unto said Village for the payment of which we bind ourselves, our successors and assigns, jointly, severally, and firmly by these presents.

THE CONDITION OF THE FOREGOING OBLIGATION IS SUCH that whereas the said Principal has entered into a written contract with the Village of Lombard, acting through the President and Board of Trustees of said Village, dated March 16, 2017, for the construction of the work designated:

2017 Traffic Signal Modernization Program

in Lombard, Illinois, which contract is hereby referred to and made a part hereof as if written herein at length, and whereby the said Principal has promised and agreed to perform said work in accordance with the terms of said contract, and has promised to pay all sums of money due for any labor, materials, apparatus, fixtures or machinery furnished to such Principal for the purpose of performing such work, and has further agreed to guaranty and maintain said work for a one (1) year period following final payment to such Principal, and has further agreed to pay all direct and indirect damages to any person, firm, company, or corporation suffered or sustained on account of the performance of such work during the time thereof and until such work is completed and accepted; and has further agreed that this bond shall inure to the benefit of any person, firm, company or corporation from whom any such labor, materials, apparatus, fixtures or machinery was so furnished and that suit may be maintained on such bond by any such person, firm, company or corporation for the recovery of any such money.

NOW, THEREFORE, if the said Principal shall well and truly perform said work in accordance with the terms of said contract and shall pay all sums of money due or to become due for any labor, materials, apparatus, fixtures or machinery furnished to him for the purpose of constructing such work and shall commence and complete the work within the time prescribed in said contract, and shall pay and discharge all damages, direct and indirect, that may be suffered or sustained on account of such work during the time of the performance thereof and until the said work shall have been accepted, and shall hold the Village of Lombard and its officers, agents and employees, harmless on account of any such damages, and shall in all respects fully and faithfully comply with all the provisions, conditions, and requirements of said contract, then upon the final payment by the Village to said Principal under said contract, the amount of this bond shall be reduced to ten percent (10%) of the amount set forth on the first page hereof for a period of one (1) year; otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, if the said Principal shall well and truly perform said guaranty and maintenance work in accordance with the terms of said contract for said one (1) year period after final payment and shall pay all sums of money due or to become due for any labor, materials, apparatus, fixtures or machinery furnished to him for the purpose of performing such guaranty and maintenance work and shall commence and complete the guaranty and maintenance work within the time prescribed in said contract, and shall pay and discharge all damages, direct and indirect, that may be suffered or sustained on account of such guaranty and maintenance work during the time of the performance thereof and until the said guaranty and maintenance work shall have been accepted, and shall hold the Village of Lombard and its officers, agents and employees, harmless on account of any such damages, and shall in all respects fully and faithfully comply with all the provisions, conditions, and requirements of said contract, then this obligation to be void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
