

Oak Creek Dr. and Finley Rd. Video Detection Upgrade

In an effort to extend the life of the new concrete on Finley at Oak Creek staff consensus is to install video detection cameras for the traffic signals instead of cutting in new loops. Attached are two cost proposals from Meade Electric. The first proposal is for the installation of loops (\$10,290) and the second is for the installation of video detection devices at a cost of \$30,000. The FY2010 Concrete Rehab Program anticipated installation of loops; however staff would recommend the installation of the video detection system. Meade Electric is our present traffic signal maintenance contractor.

Please present this project to the President and Board of Trustees at their regular meeting on June 18, 2009 for review and approval.
