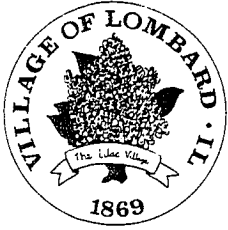

Dear Mr. Schiff:

A recent inspection of the Hill Ave. Bridge (structure # 022-3025) determined that the bridge deck is deteriorating and is no longer capable of supporting overweight loads. The capacity of the bridge is now rated for "9 Tons Maximum Axle Weight" and "37 Tons Maximum Gross Weight", the legal weight limit for trucks in Illinois. The Village of Lombard will be posting the bridge "Weight Limit, 9 Tons Axle, 37 Tons Gross" for safety concerns.
