**SUBJECT: Request for a Liquor License - El Anzuelo De Oro
621 E Roosevelt Rd**

The Village has received a request for an A/B-I liquor license from Los Cuates Corporation d/b/a El Anzuelo De Oro located at 621 E Roosevelt Road, Lombard. El Anzuelo has been open for business as a restaurant since November, 2013 and is looking to serve types of alcohol that complement their menu which is primarily Mexican cuisine. El Anzuelo's current hours of operation are 9 a.m. to 10 p.m., seven days a week. If the liquor license is granted, they would like to extend their weekend hours to 2 a.m. on Friday and Saturday.

Attached is an ordinance increasing the Class "A/B I" liquor license category by one. I have reviewed this request with Trustee Ware and he concurs with my recommendation.

ORDINANCE _____

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112,
SECTION 112.13 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN
REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS** as follows:

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13 (A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class "A/B I" liquor license, contained therein, to read as follows:

Class "A/B I" - 8

This increase in Class "A/B I" liquor licenses reflects the issuance of a Class "A/B I" liquor license to Los Cuates Corporation who will be operating the business commonly known as El Anzuelo De Oro located at 621 E Roosevelt Road, Lombard.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
