On September 7, 2020, attached Executive Order No. 2020-16 was approved which recognized the challenges brought forward by COVID-19 as it pertains to timelines for construction completion as set forth within Section 151.142 of Village Code. As staff has heard from builders and contractors, there are supply chain issues, labor availability and other uncertainties that have resulted in projects being delayed or deferred in atypical manners. Given market and labor uncertainties staff is advancing additional flexibility options to address this year's challenges. Also, staff believes the last thing the Village should be undertaking is levying contractors and permittees with additional fees, which invariably will be passed onto property owners or tenants.

Village Counsel as prepared the attached Ordinance for Village Board consideration that provides an additional 90-day time extension for all permits issued prior to October 12, 2020.

#### **EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2020-16**

### EXECUTIVE ORDER REGARDING BUILDING PERMIT EXTENSIONS UNDER A DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY IN THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS

(COVID-19 - September 7, 2020)

- WHEREAS, the Village of Lombard (the "Village") is a non-home rule unit of local government, as provided by Article VII, Section 7 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and
- WHEREAS, COVID-19 is a dangerous disease which has spread around the world, including in the United States, the State of Illinois and DuPage County; and
- WHEREAS, COVID-19 is a direct and serious threat to the public's health, safety and welfare; and
- WHEREAS, on March 20, 2020, the Village President declared a state of emergency in the Village in Declaration 2020-1, entitled "Declaration of a State of Emergency in the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois (COVID-19 March 20, 2020)" (the "Declaration"); and
- WHEREAS, the Declaration was made pursuant to authority granted to the Village President in Section 31.18 of the Lombard Village Code, entitled "Village President's Authority to Declare a State of Emergency," and pursuant to Section 11-1-6 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-1-6); and
- **WHEREAS**, the Village President has determined that it is necessary to make this Executive Order to best protect the public's health, safety and welfare regarding COVID-19;
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED,** by the Village President of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:
- **SECTION 1:** Incorporation. That the recitals above shall be and are incorporated in this Section 1 as if restated herein.

#### **SECTION 2**: **Executive Order**. That it is ordered as follows:

1. In light of the COVID-19 pandemic's adverse impacts on the ability to complete construction projects in a timely manner, the following time requirements, as set forth in Section 150.142 of the Lombard Village Code, relative to construction projects, and the permits issued in relation thereto, as hereby extended, as set forth below, for all projects which, as of the effective date of this Executive Order, have been issued a building permit(s):

# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 15, CHAPTER 150, SECTION 150.142 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO TIME LIMITS FOR BUILDING PERMITS

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 15, Chapter 150, Section 150.142 of the Lombard Village Code is amended by adding a new subsection (J) thereto, which shall read in its entirety as follows:

"(J) In light of the COVID-19 pandemic's adverse impacts on the ability to complete construction projects in a timely manner, the following time requirements, as set forth in subsections (D), (E), (F) and (I) above, relative to construction projects, and the permits issued in relation thereto, are hereby extended, as set forth below, for all projects which, as of October 12, 2020, have been issued a building permit(s):
