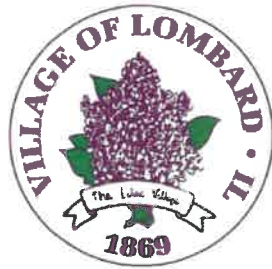

**Subject:** FY 2020 Asphalt Paving Program RM PROG 22, 23, 24, 26

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The Engineering Division, in collaboration with the Streets Division, is recommending the following streets to be improved as part of the 2020 Asphalt Paving program:

Preliminary Choices – Estimate: \$1,433,231

Ahrens Court – Maple Street to cul-de-sac  
Brewster Avenue – Maple Street to Edson Street  
Craig Place – Ash Street to Madison Street  
Edgewood Avenue – St. Charles Place to Maple Street  
Edson Street – Brewster Avenue to Madison Street  
Fairfield Avenue – Butterfield Road to dead end south  
Gilmore Lane – west lot line of Carlyle to Fairfield Avenue  
Kelly Court – Washington Blvd to cul-de-sac  
Kenilworth Avenue – Westmore-Meyers Road to dead end east  
Kenilworth Court – private street to Kenilworth Avenue  
Lewis Avenue – St. Charles Place to Maple Street  
Lombard Avenue – Maple Street to Morningside Avenue  
Madison Street – Finley Road to Park Road  
Main Street – Graham Avenue to Roosevelt Road  
Northlake Drive – St. Regis Drive to 22<sup>nd</sup> Street  
St. Regis Drive – Highland Avenue to 22<sup>nd</sup> Street  
Stewart Avenue – Maple Street to Morningside Avenue  
Washington Blvd – Westmore-Meyers Road to Addison Avenue  
Wilson Avenue – Main Street east to end of concrete panels  
2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue – Kenilworth Avenue to Emerson Avenue  
3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue – dead end north to Kenilworth Avenue  
3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue – Kenilworth Avenue to Emerson Avenue

With the implementation 2 years ago of the Asset Management System, decision making has improved. Data regarding the condition of streets and utilities, coming from our pavement ratings inventory and the resulting OCI reports, have been used again this year in aiding of the selection of streets to be resurfaced. The estimated cost of the recommended improvements is \$1,433,231.00.

A determination of which roadways will be paved by the Contractor and those that will be paved by Village staff will be made prior to the bid.

The targeted letting date for this project is March 26, 2020. Please provide a recommendation at your earliest convenience so that plans can be finalized and advertised for bid.
