SUBJECT: Amendment to Title 11, Chapter 119, of the Lombard Village Code in  
Regard to Food Delivery Vehicles

Please find attached an Ordinance amending the Village Code in regard to Food Delivery Vehicles. Individuals and entities who are seeking a food delivery license, that will sell foodstuffs to the public for immediate consumption, and the members of the public to whom the sales of said foodstuffs will occur include, as a significant portion thereof, individuals under the age of eighteen (18), will have to provide additional information on their business license application form relative to the drivers of the food delivery vehicles.

This additional information will allow for a background check to make sure that no license is issued to any person or entity who has a listed driver who is a "child sex offender" as defined by 720 ILCS 5/11-9.3(c)(1).

**SECTION 3:** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after

“(C) No license required by Section 119.10 above shall be issued to any person or entity, that is subject to the license application requirements of the second sentence of Section 119.11(A) above, in the event that a check of the drivers of the food delivery vehicles listed on the application reveals that one (1) or more of said listed drivers is a “child sex offender” as defined by 720 ILCS 5/11-9.3(c)(1).”

**SECTION 2:** That Title 11, Chapter 119, Section 119.13 of the Lombard Village

“In the event that direct sales of foodstuffs to the public, for immediate consumption by said members of the public, will occur from the licensed vehicle, and the members of the public to whom the sales of said foodstuffs will occur include, as a significant portion thereof, individuals under the age of eighteen (18), said applications for such licenses shall also include the name, address, date of birth, drivers license number and state of issuance of said drivers license, for each individual that will be driving a food delivery vehicle within the Village.”
