RE PARKING SIGNAGE PROPOSAL

I am making this proposal in an effort to resolve an ongoing parking problem in the area of the Commuter parking lots located around Maple and Park.

Gerri Long from the Library complains about "commuters" parking in the designated "Library Parking" slots. The "commuters" are advised that if the north lot is full, proceed to the south commuter lot located on the south side of Maple off of Park.

This smaller "south lot" is marked as "Commuter Parking" only. However, there are five slots marked for "Museum Parking" only. The problem with this lot is that patrons from the "Jazzercise" classes at the 1ST Church have been parking in this lot. This occurs as a result of the church's parking lot being filled and the "No Parking" restriction on Ash west of Main.

This parking restriction on Ash reads "No Parking 7am - 10am"; except Sundays and Holidays.

I spoke with Mary Peters who teaches "Jazzercise". The first class starts at 0915. Classes take place on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, & Friday.

I am requesting that this signage be amended. I would propose that the signage read "No Parking 6am – 9am"; except Saturdays, Sundays, & Holidays. Quite frankly, most commuters are on the train by 0900. The number of commuters on Saturdays and Sundays are much less.

This would also allow the "Jazzercise" clientele to park on Ash when their lot is full.

RE ASH STREET PARKING PERMISSION

Special parking permission has been granted to the patrons of "Jazzercise" who use the 1st Church facility at 220 S. Main.

Due to limited parking in the church parking lot, patrons have been given permission to park their cars on Ash Street. These patrons were instructed to park their cars west of the church exit drive on Ash.
