TITLE: Local Government Taxpayers' Bill of Rights

BACKGROUND/POLICY IMPLICATIONS:

In January 2003, the State of Illinois began collecting the Simplified Municipal Telecommunications Tax. This tax replaces the Telecommunications Tax and Infrastructure Maintenance Fee. Since these taxes and fees are no longer collected directly by the Village, they no longer need to be included in the Village Code as taxes and fees subject to the Local Government Taxpayers' Bill of Rights Act.

In June 2003, the Places for Eating Tax became effective. Therefore, this tax needs to be added to the listing of taxes and fees covered by the Local Government Taxpayers' Bill of Rights Act.

The attached ordinance relects these changes.

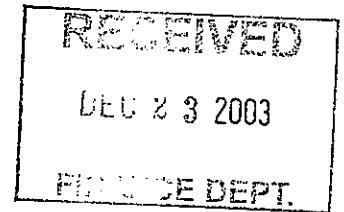

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 9, CHAPTER 9, SECTION 98.110(A)  
OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO THE LOCAL  
GOVERNMENT TAXPAYERS' BILL OF RIGHTS ACT**

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 9, Chapter 98, Section 98.110(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended as follows:

A. Subsection 3 is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

“3. Tax on the Gross Receipts of Places for Eating - See Title 9, Chapter 98, Section 98.111 of this Code.”

B. Subsection 4 is repealed; and

C. Subsection 5 shall be renumbered as Subsection 4.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
