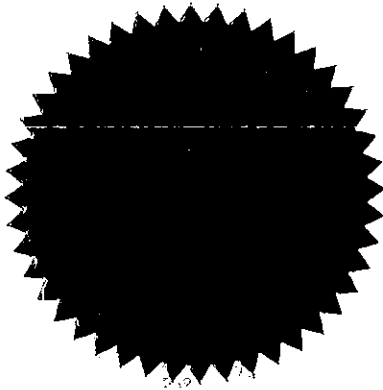

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION OF THE QUESTION OF WHETHER THE ANNUAL LIBRARY TAX FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION IN THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD SHOULD BE INCREASED FROM 0.25% TO 0.31% TO THE ELECTORS OF THE VILLAGE AT THE GENERAL PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE 16TH DAY OF MARCH, 2004

WHEREAS, pursuant to 75 ILCS 5/3-4, a petition has been filed in the office of the Village Clerk requesting that a tax rate increase referendum, on behalf of the Helen M. Plum Memorial Library, be placed on the ballot for the March 16, 2004 general primary election; and WHEREAS, said petition contains more than the one hundred (100) signatures, as required by 75 ILCS 5/2-2, said requirement being incorporated by reference in 75 ILCS 5/3-4;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the following proposition shall be submitted to the voters of the Village of Lombard (the "Village") at the general primary election to be held on Tuesday, the 16th day of March, 2004 (the "Election"):

"Shall the annual library tax for maintenance and operation in the Village of Lombard be increased from 0.25% to 0.31%?"

SECTION 2: That the Election shall be held in the voting precincts and at the polling places established for the Village by the Board of Election Commissioners of DuPage County, Illinois (the "Election Commissioners").

SECTION 3: That notice of said Election shall be given in accordance with The Election Code of the State of Illinois, 10 ILCS 5/1-1 et seq., (the "Code") by the Executive Director of the Election Commissioners by publishing Notice thereof once in one or more newspapers published in the Village of Lombard, and if none, then published once in a local, community newspaper, having general circulation in the Village of Lombard, and also once in a newspaper published in DuPage County, the date of such publication of such notice to be at least ten (10)

days prior to the date of said Election, but not more than thirty (30) days prior to the date of said Election, all in accordance with Article 12 of the Code.

SECTION 4: That where the an electronic, mechanical, or electric voting system ("Electronic Voting System") is used at the Election, a true and legible copy of the specimen ballot label to be used at the Election shall be published and made available for public distribution and shall be supplied to the judges of said Election for posting in the polling places on the date of the Election, as required by §24A-18 of the Code.

SECTION 5: That it is hereby found and determined that the Lombard Spectator, is a local community newspaper having general circulation in the Village as required by §§ 12-4 and 12-5 of the Code.

SECTION 6: That said Notice shall include the following:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at the general primary election held on Tuesday, March 16, 2004, the following question will be submitted to the voters of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois:

"Shall the annual library tax for maintenance and operation in the Village of Lombard be increased from 0.25% to 0.31%?"

The polls will be open at 6:00 a.m. and will continue to be open until 7:00 p.m. on that day.

SECTION 8: That the Election shall be conducted by the election judges appointed by the

Election Commissioners to act in the voting precincts at which said proposition will be submitted

to the voters of the Village.

SECTION 9: That the Deputy Clerk of this Village shall, not less sixty-one (61) days

before the regularly scheduled general primary election to be held on March 16, 2004, certify to

the Election Commissioners, the proposition as hereinabove set forth to be submitted to the voters of this Village at said Election. Such certification shall include the form of the public question to be placed on the ballot, the date on which the public question was initiated by the adoption of this Ordinance, and a certified copy of this Ordinance, and shall be substantially in the form of EXHIBIT A attached hereto and hereby made a part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 10: That said Election shall be held and conducted and the returns thereof duly canvassed, all in the manner and the time provided by law.

SECTION 11: That all orders, resolutions and ordinances, and parts thereof, in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, and that this Ordinance be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval as provided by law.




