**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 3, CHAPTER 31 OF  
THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO  
TERM LIMITS FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** That Title 3, Chapter 31 of the Lombard Village Code is amended by adding a new Section 31.06 thereto, which shall read in its entirety as follows:

**“§31.06 TERM LIMITS FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS**

Pursuant to the binding referendum approved at the November 6, 2012 election, the terms of office for those persons elected to the offices of Village President, Village Clerk or Trustee in the Village of Lombard, at the April 9, 2013 consolidated election and at each election for any of said offices thereafter, are hereby limited such that no person so elected may serve more than three (3) consecutive full four (4) year terms in the same office. In this regard, once a person serves three (3) consecutive full four (4) year terms in a particular office, said person may not serve again in said particular office until after another person has first served in said particular office.”

**SECTION 2:** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
