SUBJECT: Pace Routes 715 and 747

BACKGROUND

As part of its 2010 service operating budget, Pace has proposed the elimination of Saturday service on Route 715 and on Route 747, the elimination of weekday service between Wheaton and West Chicago and all Saturday service. The Village of Lombard is centrally located on both of these routes, at Yorktown Center for Route 715 and along Roosevelt Road for Route 747 (as shown on the attached maps).

At the October 20, 2008 Pace budget public hearing, Village staff spoke in favor of maintaining existing service levels on Routes 715 and 747. These bus routes are critical components of the existing transportation network. In addition, they are important connecting services for the Lombard circulator, which is scheduled to begin service in 2010. The circulator was designed to fill the gaps in the existing transportation network to connect Lombard residents, employees, and visitors to the regional Pace and Metra services. Therefore, it is necessary to maintain Pace service for the circulator to connect to.

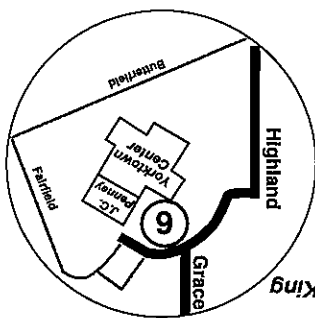
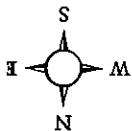
Staff recommends that the Village Board pass the attached resolution supporting the continuation of existing bus service levels on Pace Routes 715 and 747.

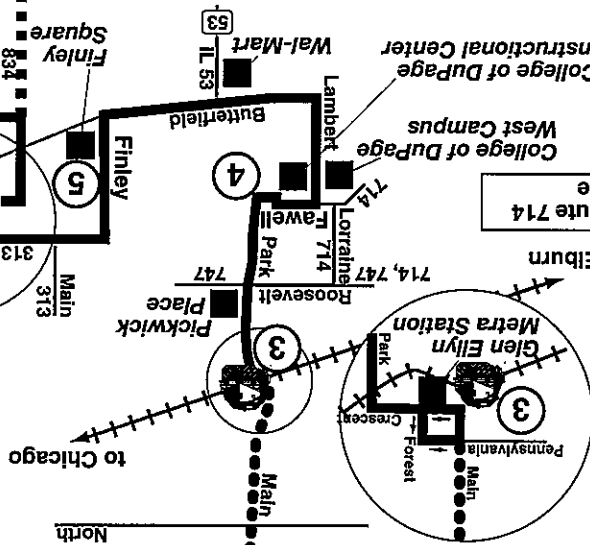
Route 715

Transfer to Pace Route 714 at College of DuPage

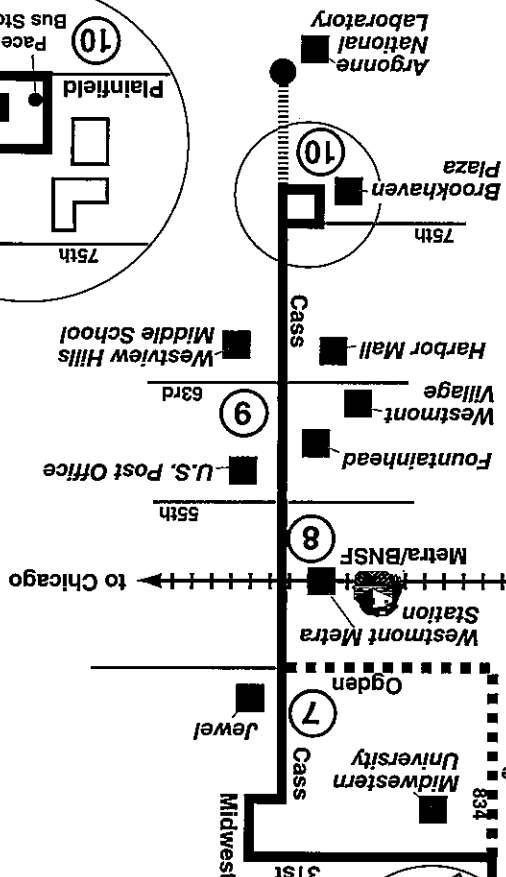
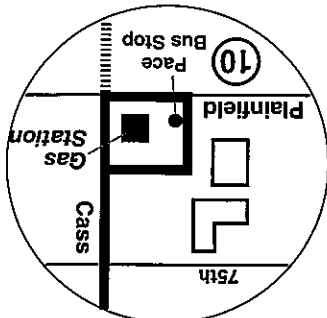
All Pace service is wheelchair accessible.

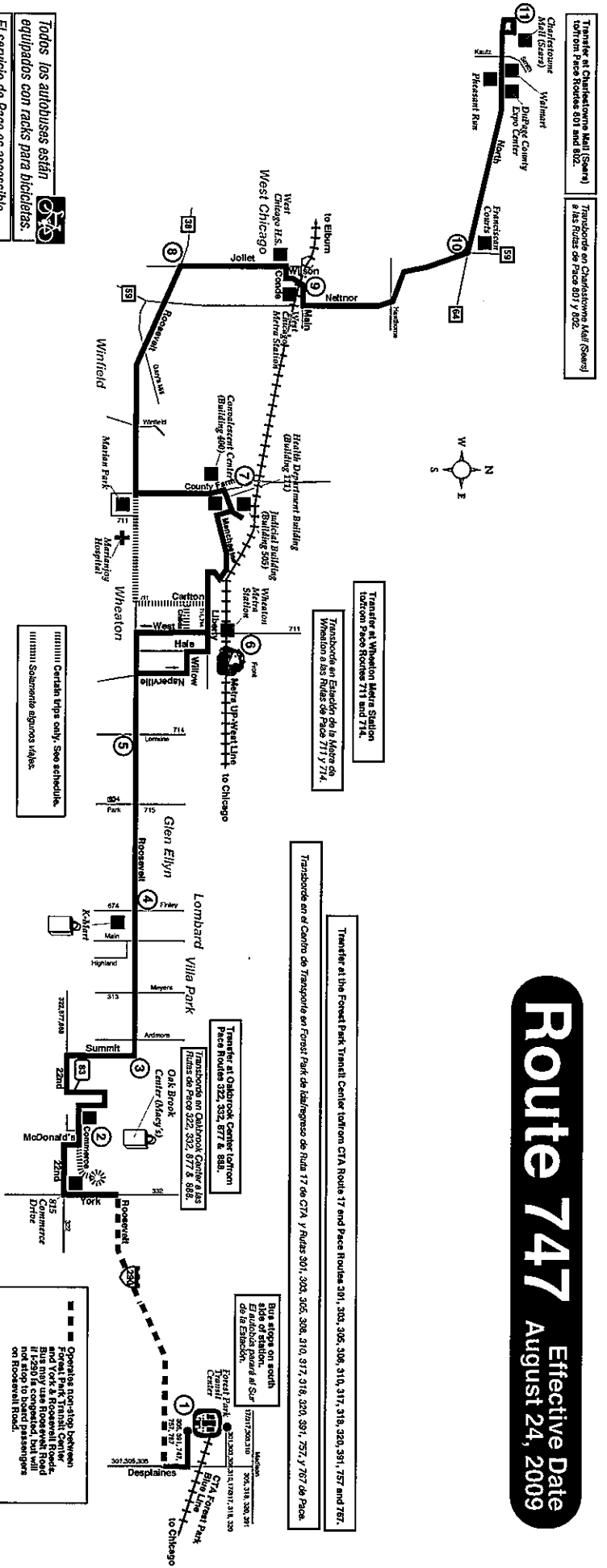
