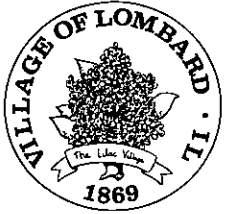



Subject: Award Bid #FS0709, one 2007 tandem axle dump truck with plow

The FY 2007 budget includes replacement of ST343, a single axle dump truck with plow. The bid results are as follows:

Vendor	Bid Price	Less Trade-In	Net Total Bid
Northwest Ford Franklin Park, IL	159,994	11,000	148,994
Freeway Ford Lyons, IL	162,945	20,350	142,595

Public Works received two sealed bids. Freeway Ford was low bidder. The bid price for the 2007 tandem axle dump truck with plow is \$162,945 less a trade-in allowance of \$20,350 equals a net total bid of \$142,595. The budgeted amount for this vehicle is \$160,000.

I recommend the award of a contract to Freeway Ford of Lyons, IL. in the amount of \$142,595. I also recommend declaring village unit number SM328, A 1994 Ford tandem axle dump truck with plow, as surplus per the attached ordinance and authorizing its trade-in. Waiver of first reading is requested on this ordinance. Please submit this item to the Village Board for their consideration at the April 6, 2006 meeting.

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND/OR DISPOSAL
OF MUNICIPAL OWNED PERSONAL PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard, it is no longer necessary or useful to or in the best interest for the Village of Lombard to retain the following described personal property:

SM328 1994 Ford LTS8000 dump truck with plow VIN #1FDYY82E6RVA20056

now owned by the Village of Lombard; and

WHEREAS, The Village routinely declares such type of personal property surplus and the best interest of the Village of Lombard will be served by its sale and/or disposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

now owned by the Village of Lombard is no longer necessary or useful to the Village of Lombard and the best interest of Lombard will be served by its sale/trade-in to Freeway Ford of Lyons, Illinois in the amount of \$20,350.00.

Section 2: Pursuant to said 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the Village President and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to sell and/or dispose of the aforementioned personal property now owned by the Village of Lombard.
