Re: Proposed Changes to the North Park Parking Lot

As you know, we are always evaluating the availability of parking spaces in the downtown business district, both for business owners and customers. In communicating with our community service officers, it has been brought to my attention that some of the spaces in the North Park parking lot could be better utilized. Specifically, there are currently 23 parking spaces designated as 2 hour parking at the south end of the lot. On a general basis, these spaces are usually only 50% occupied at any given time.

The proposed change would include converting eleven (11) of these 2 hour parking spaces to permit parking. This would increase the total number of spaces available for business owners and their employees to park all day, as well as free up spaces on St. Charles Road in front of stores. By looking at the map attached to the ordinance (Exhibit "A"), the row of parking spaces to be converted are located between the signs designated as 24 and 25. Given the fact that these spaces are generally only used at a 50% rate right now, there should be no impact to customers or shoppers on a daily basis. However, there will be a direct benefit to business owners and employees.

In conjunction with this proposed change, it is our intention to strictly enforce the two-hour parking provisions as posted in the downtown area. Strict enforcement should help to objectively provide open parking space availability for all of the businesses in the area. A waiver of first reading is also being requested in order to expedite the availability of the spaces.
