FY 2011 Bituminous Mix Alternate Supplier

At the June 3, 2010 Board meeting, the Village Board approved a contract for Dukane Asphalt Company to supply bituminous mix to the Village. An order was placed with Matt Dunteman, Plant Manager for DuKane Asphalt, on June 9th. The quantities needed and dates the material would be needed were provided to the contractor at that time. On Tuesday, June 22nd, Public Works received a call from Matt Dunteman, informing us that they would not be able to supply asphalt to us on Wednesday, June 23rd for the paving of North Elizabeth Street. The reason given was that all asphalt produced that day was going to be allocated to the Eisenhower Expressway project. DuPage Materials was then contacted to see if they were able to supply 625 tons of N50 surface asphalt. They were able to provide the needed asphalt at a price of \$54.75 per ton.

Per Tim Sextion, Finance Director, this situation met the requirements for an emergency purchase under the Emergency Purchase Policy. Upon Village Manager approval, the asphalt was supplied by DuPage Materials at a total cost of \$29,921.81.

Public Works is requesting a waiver of bids and award of a contract to DuPage Materials not to exceed \$29,921.81 for the purchase of Bituminous Mix. This was approved by the Village Manager under the Emergency Purchase Policy section as allowed by the Finance Department Purchasing Manual.
