The Committees...

Board of Building Appeals

The Board is responsible for amending the building code to ensure proper development. The Board also hears appeals involving decisions on the interpretation of the building code.

Board of Fire and Police Commissioners

The Commission is responsible for all appointments, promotions, demotions and dismissals of personnel within the Police and Fire departments except the chief.

Board of Local Improvements

The Board of Local Improvements, often referred to as "BOLI", was created under State Statute to initiate all special assessment projects and release contracts pertaining to each project. The Committee also maintains records of those residents affected by a special assessment.

The Plan Commission was created under State Statute to advise the Village Board on the development and land use of the Village.

Zoning Board of Appeals

The ZBA is responsible for reviewing all requests for variations and administering appeals of the Lombard Zoning Ordinance.

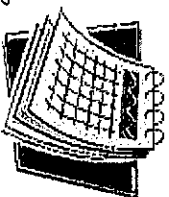

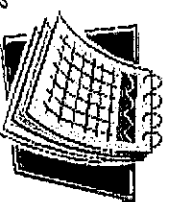

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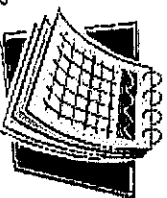
