

ORDINANCE NO. _____

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
TITLE 9, CHAPTER 97, SECTION 97.200
OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE
IN REGARD TO PERMITS FOR OVERWEIGHT AND/OR
OVERDIMENSION VEHICLES ON VILLAGE STREETS**

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 9, Chapter 97, Section 97.200 of the Lombard Village Code is hereby amended as follows:

- A. In subsection (A), the reference to “73,280 pounds” is amended to read, “80,000 pounds.”
- B. In subsection (A), the reference to “more than 60 feet” is amended to read, “more than 60 feet (truck tractor-semitrailer-trailer, truck tractor semitrailer-semitrailer, or combinations specifically designed to transport motor vehicles or boats), or more than 55 feet (truck tractor in combination with a semitrailer).”
- C. In subsection (A), insert “(6)” between the words “six” and “inches.”
- D. In subsection (A), the reference to “18,000 pounds” is amended to read, “20,000 pounds.”
- E. In subsection (A), the reference to “32,000 pounds” is amended to read, “34,000 pounds.”
- F. In subsection (F), delete all but the first two (2) sentences.
- G. In subsection (G), add the following to the end thereof: “The Village of Lombard must be added as a certificate holder. The failure to keep a certificate of insurance on file with the Village, evidencing that the required

insurance is in full force and effect and that the Village of Lombard is a certificate holder, shall render a permit issued under this Section null and void.”

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
