Amendments to Chapter 12: Prosecution of Ordinance Violations

As part of staff's review of process and code review provisions, Village Counsel identified a provision within Chapter 12.10 pertaining to the prosecution of ordinance violations that had not been properly amended. Sometime between 1991 and 2009 the fees for a violation notice (attached) had been adjusted, but the provisions of Chapter 12 were not properly amended.

Staff is bringing this matter to the Village Board accordingly as a housekeeping matter. Attached is an ordinance that will:

- 1. Include a reference to the use of Administrative Adjudication in addition to court;
- 2. Memorialize the current fee structure within Chapter 12; and
- 3. Correct naming conventions of the Community Development Department.

This amendment does not change enforcement operations and staff will still strive for compliance rather than fines. Utilization of the compliance ticket option has been intended to be an option, when deemed appropriate, to encourage compliance after a notification had been sent to a property owner but before a formal ticket requiring a court appearance is issued.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE I, CHAPTER 12 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO THE PROSECUTION OF ORDINANCE VIOLATIONS

ORDINANCE NO.	
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AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE I, CHAPTER 12 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO THE PROSECUTION OF ORDINANCE VIOLATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title I, Chapter 12, Section 12.01(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"(A) Prosecution for the violation of any Village ordinance, except as set forth in subsection (B) below, and except as prosecuted through administrative adjudication pursuant to Chapter 12 or Chapter 100 of this Code, shall be in the Circuit Court for the Eighteenth Judicial Circuit, DuPage County, Illinois."

SECTION 2: That Title I, Chapter 12, Section 12.10(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the reference therein to "\$10.00" to read "\$50.00," and by revising the reference therein to "\$20.00" to read, "\$100.00."

SECTION 3: That Title I, Chapter 12, Section 12.10(B) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the references therein to the "Department of Planning" to read the "Community Development Department".

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
