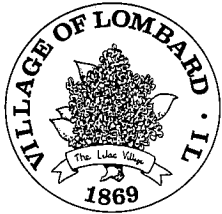

Subject: Pleasant Lane School – No Parking Signage on Charlotte

During construction on Pleasant Ln., "No Parking" signs were installed on Charlotte to improve traffic flow. The "No Parking" signage was installed on the east and west sides of Charlotte from Pleasant Ln. to 150 feet south. Now that construction is complete the need for 150 foot "No Parking" zone is no longer needed. A shorter "No Parking" zone will keep the intersection clear and provide good visibility for children crossing at the intersection.

I would recommend installing "No Parking" signage on the east and west side of Charlotte from the south curb line on Pleasant to a point 50 feet south.
