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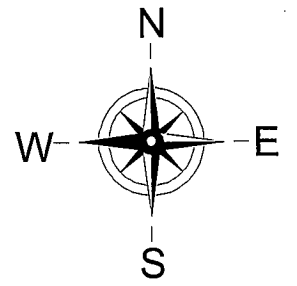

Subject: Installation of a Stop Sign on Progress at Main

At the August 3, 1998, Transportation and Safety Committee meeting the committee requested that I perform a traffic study at Progress and Main for warranting a stop sign. Attached for your review is a drawing of the intersection showing the deficiencies. On westbound Progress approaching Main there is a parking lot just off the street that extends to within 15 feet of Main. When vehicles are parked there, the available sight distance is greatly reduced to the point where you need to stop, then proceed with caution.

Based on the above information, I would recommend converting the yield sign on Progress at Main to a stop sign.

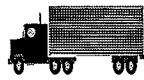
