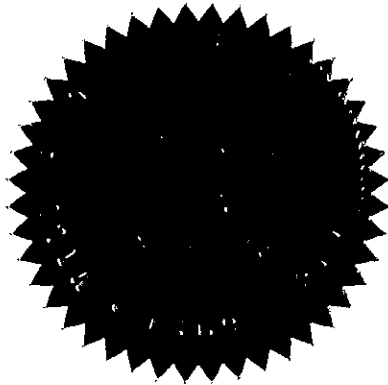



AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 123 OF THE
LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO RAFFLES

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard,
DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 11, Chapter 123, Section 123.02(A) of the Lombard Village Code
is amended by adding the following language to the end of the first sentence thereof:

" , or to a non-profit fund-raising organization that the Village determines is
organized for the sole purpose of providing financial assistance to an identified
individual or group of individuals suffering extreme financial hardship as the result
of an illness, disability, accident or disaster."

SECTION 2: That Title 11, Chapter 123, Section 123.02(B) of the Lombard Village Code
is amended by adding a new subsection (6) thereto which will read in its entirety as follows:

"(6) Any organization in which a person defined in (B)(1), (2), or (3) is an officer,
director, or employee whether compensated or not."

SECTION 3: That Title 11, Chapter 123, Section 123.03(A)(4) of the Lombard Village
Code is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"(4) A license authorizes the licensee to conduct a raffle(s) as defined in Section
123.01 of this Code. The following fees shall be applicable relative to the issuance of raffle licenses:

- (a) 1 to 3 raffles during a calendar year – \$5.00 per raffle;
- (b) 4 to 12 raffles during a calendar year – \$25.00;
- (c) More than 12 raffles during a calendar year – \$50.00."

SECTION 4: That Title 11, Chapter 123, Section 123.04 of the Lombard Village Code
is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"§123.04 CONDUCT OF RAFFLES; PREMISES.

- (A) The conducting of raffles is subject to the following restrictions:
- (1) The entire net proceeds of any raffle must be exclusively devoted to the lawful purposes of the organization permitted to conduct that game.
 - (2) No person except a bona fide member of the sponsoring organization may participate in the management or operation of the raffle.
 - (3) No person may receive any remuneration or profit for participating in the management or operation of the raffle.
 - (4) A licensee may rent a premises on which to determine the winning chance or chances in a raffle only from an organization which is also licensed under this Article.
 - (5) Raffle chances may be sold or issued only within the area specified on the license and winning chances may be determined only at those locations specified on the license.
 - (6) No person under the age of eighteen (18) years may participate in the conducting of raffles or chances. A person under the age of eighteen (18) years may be within the area where winning chances are being determined only when accompanied by his parent or guardian.
- (B) If a lessor rents premises where a winning chance or chances for a raffle are determined, the lessor shall not be criminally liable if the person who uses the premises for the determining of winning chances does not hold a license."

SECTION 5: That Title 11, Chapter 123, Section 123.06(C) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by adding the following language after the word "report":

"promptly and in no event later than"

SECTION 6: That Title 11, Chapter 123, Section 123.07 of the Lombard Village Code is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"§123.07 **ADDITIONAL RESTRICTIONS.**

- (A) The aggregate retail value of all prizes and merchandise awarded by a licensee in a single raffle shall not exceed two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000.00).
- (B) The maximum retail value of each prize awarded in a single raffle shall not exceed two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000.00).
- (C) The maximum price which may be charged for each raffle chance issued or sold shall not exceed two hundred dollars (\$200.00).
- (D) The maximum number of days during which chances may be issued or sold for a specific raffle shall not exceed one hundred eighty (180) days."

SECTION 7: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.




