Subject: Proposed Cellphone Contract

The Village's present cellphone contract is with AT&T under the Federal Government's contract. Cingular and AT&T have merged and Cingular recently stopped accepting customers for AT&T's system. When cellphones fail, Cingular is switching that individual service to Cingular system at a higher cost.

Staff has been working with both Cingular and Sprint/Nextel on a new contract for the Village's cellphone service. The two firms recently provided proposals. Sprint/Nextel's proposal provides the Village with more options and is less than Cingular's proposal. The following chart summarizes the Proposals.

The cost of converting to the new provider will be recouped in the first year. The contract is a 2 year contract with no early termination fees. Additionally Nextel's features enhance the Village's communication options with its direct connect feature during emergencies.

Recommend the Board authorize Village Manager William Lichter to execute the contract with Sprint/Nextel for cellular phone services.
