Motion to Accept a Stormwater Detention Easement at 200 W. Roosevelt

(Route 38 Autowash & Detail)

The former Turtle Wax car wash site was recently renovated and expanded. As part of these improvements, the new contract purchasers were required to provide stormwater detention for the area of the proposed new construction. Village Code requires that said detention is placed within an easement that provides the Village with access for inspections and the right, but not the responsibility, to maintain.
