| Modification of Vehicle Immobilization Ordinance 72.04 (B) (4) | |
| The vehicle immobilization ordinance as written does not give direction when persons have the immobilization removed by paying \$15 per unpaid parking citation and then fail to enter into a payment plan agreement. The ordinance also requires that the payment plan agreement is made within 24 hours of the vehicle immobilization device being removed. This time period has proven to be too short. The attached ordinance modification addresses both items as follows: | |
| Persons who fail to enter into a payment plan agreement after removal of the vehicle immobilization within 72 hours will now be eligible to have their vehicle immobilized again and will have to pay the full amount owed in order to have the vehicle immobilization device removed. | |
