FY 2022-2023 Season Road Salt Purchase

The 2021-2022 winter season has required the Village to use approximately 3200 tons of the road salt supply that it had in reserve. This is approximately 600 tons more than what we have averaged over the last three years.

The Village had previously participated in DuPage County Department of Transportation's salt bid. Bids for this contract were opened April 15, 2022. Morton Salt, Inc. was the lowest bidder with a per ton cost of \$75.88 and will be the provider of bulk road salt for the County's contract.

Staff would like to exercise the option of purchasing up to 130% of the requested 2,700 tons of salt to replenish the salt that was used during the 2021-2022 season. Village staff excercised the option to only purchase 80% of the contract allotted salt from the 2021-2022 salt contract anticipating lower cost per ton for the 2022-2023 season..

The Village has approximately 3200 tons of salt in reserve in the salt storage dome. The Village can begin to accept deliveries of salt under the 2022-2023 contract in June 2022.

Salt purchase of \$266,338.00 will be paid for by the MFT fund 420.730.730.73310 in FY 2022.
