Lombard seeking future leaders

The Village of Lombard would like to invite Lombard high school students considering a career in the government or public service to come to Village Hall for a chance to learn from staff and elected officials.

The program will take place over the course of three, 2-hour sessions on Thursday nights at Village Hall. In the first two classes, leaders from the Village Manager's Office, Finance, Community Development, Public Works, Police and Fire Departments will give interactive presentations about their specific field and answer questions from students. In the third and final session, students will get a chance to meet with the Village President and Board of Trustees before the regular board meeting. Students will attend the meeting to observe the local government process and will be presented with a certificate of completion for the program.

The class size will be kept small so students get one-on-one attention from Village Hall staff. Staff will also share contact information in order to serve as future mentors as students apply for colleges and eventually transition into careers.
