Request for Extension of Parking, Stopping and Standing
Prohibition on Lombard Rd north of Cortland Ct.

On July 13th, 2016, CSO Pokorny was called to B. Haney and Sons Tree Care, 1200 N. Lombard Rd, for a parking complaint. The business owner, Dan Haney, advised that both sides of Lombard Rd. south of Cortland Ct are posted "No Parking, Stopping, or Standing", but Lombard Rd. north of that location is not. He advised that this has resulted in vehicles parking in the recently created cul-de-sac north of Cortland Ct where his business is. The roadway used to be a dead end. He advised that his trucks now have a difficult time leaving and entering his business. He requested that Lombard Rd. north of Cortland Ct. be posted "No Parking, Stopping, or Standing" as well.

The current ordinance (Schedule XX) prohibits stopping, parking, or standing on both sides of Lombard Rd north of North Ave (IL64) to "the dead end".

The spirit of the ordinance clearly means to establish a prohibition of parking, stopping, and standing in the area in question. The area is industrial and the ordinance was very likely meant to prevent the types of problems that Mr. Haney is experiencing. Because of
