**Request for Extension of Parking, Stopping, and Standing Prohibition on Lombard Rd. North of Cortland Ct.**

The owners of Haney and Sons Tree Care, 1200 N. Lombard Rd., have requested that the parking, stopping, and standing prohibitions present on Lombard Rd. south of their business be extended into the cul-de-sac that was recently created at the northern end of Lombard Rd. near their business. They state that vehicles parking in the cul-de-sac interfere with traffic from their business.

The current ordinance (Schedule XX) prohibits stopping, parking, or standing on both sides of Lombard Rd north of North Ave (IL64) to "the dead end".

The spirit of the ordinance clearly means to establish a prohibition of parking, stopping, and standing in the area in question. The area is industrial and the ordinance was very likely meant to prevent the types of problems that Mr. Haney is experiencing. Because of this, staff recommends modifying the existing ordinance to prohibit stopping, standing, and stopping for the entirety of Lombard Rd north of North Ave.

During the September 12<sup>th</sup>, 2016 meeting, the Public Safety and Transportation and Safety Committee voted to recommend adding the parking restriction in accordance with the attached staff recommendation.

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Safety Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Schedule XX of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) is amended to at the following restriction:

"The entirety of Lombard Rd north of North Ave."

Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication in pamphlet form and the posting of appropriate signs as provided by law.
