## Jingle Bell Jubilee: The Nutcracker Window Suite

### Program:

Jingle Bell Jubilee is a community-wide holiday event held in the downtown Lombard area hosted by the Lombard Park District, Village of Lombard, Helen Plum Library, Lombard Historical Society, Lombard Town Centre, and Maple Street Chapel. Visitors enjoy the beautiful holiday lights in Lilacia Park, meet Santa, hear stories, listen to carolers, participate in activities, drink hot cocoa, take a Trolley ride and watch scenes from the Nutcracker Ballet in downtown business windows.

Lombard Town Centre in partnership with The Dance Centre produced the Nutcracker Window Suite. The Nutcracker Window Suite is a series of scenes from the Nutcracker Ballet located in five different business windows. Dance Centre dancers performed in the following shop windows: The Cellar, Fairy Tales, The Corner House, ClaSha and The Hair Experts. Audiences strolled through downtown Lombard watching each scene. Rudolph was also there to help engage the crowd. Downtown restaurants and businesses reported good size crowds and positive experiences throughout the evening.
