FY2017 New Equipment Purchase

Included in the FY2017 budget is the replacement for Public Works Forestry Division unit number FO940, a 2010 Vermeer BC1500 brush chipper. Staff identified two chipper models which would suite the Forestry Division's needs (the Vermeer AX19 and the Brush Bandit 18XP). Staff has tried both of these machines in the field. Both machines performed comparable however the Brush Bandit cost considerably less therefore staff would recommend the Brush Bandit as a replacement.

The Brush Bandit 18XP is available for joint purchase through the Nation Joint Purchasing Alliance (NJPA) contract # 031014-BAN. The local dealer for Brush Bandit is Atlas Bobcat. The NJPA cost of the chipper is \$67,322.16. Atlas Bobcat has offered us \$18,000 in trade for our old chipper so the net cost of this purchase is \$49,322.16. The amount we have in reserve for this purchase is \$60,000.

I recommend the Board of Trustees award a contract to Atlas Bobcat in the amount of \$49,322.16 for one new Brush Bandit 18XP brush chipper. I also recommend declaring Village unit number FO940 as surplus per the attached ordinance and authorize its tradein to Atlas Bobcat. Waiver of first reading is requested on this ordinance. Please submit this item to the Village Board for their consideration at the February 2, 2017 meeting.
