FY2017 New Equipment Purchase

Included in the FY2017 budget is the replacement for Public Works Street Division unit number ST907, a 2006 Spaulding asphalt hot box. Staff would like to replace this hot box with a similar model the Street Division has (a Falcon 4-ton hot box with dump feature). This model hot box has proven reliable and will create uniformity in the fleet.

The Falcon hot box is available for joint purchase through the Nation Joint Purchasing Alliance (NJPA) contract # 113012-FRM. The local dealer for Falcon Road Equipment is Midwest Paving Equipment Inc. The NJPA cost of the hot box is \$30,413.00. The budgeted amount for this purchase is \$32,000. We will also see additional proceeds from the sale of our old hot box at public auction.

I recommend the Board of Trustees award a contract to Midwest Paving Equipment Inc. in the amount of \$30,413.00 for one new Falcon 4-ton hot box. I also recommend declaring Village unit number ST907 as surplus per the attached ordinance and authorize its sale at public auction. Waiver of first reading is requested on this ordinance. Please submit this item to the Village Board for their consideration at the February 2, 2017 meeting.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE BY PUBLIC AUCTION OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard, it is no longer necessary or useful to or in the best interest for the Village of Lombard to retain ownership of the personal property hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard to sell said personal property at public auction to be held by Obenauf Auction Service. Vehicles valued less than the cost of auction fees and would not result in a net profit for the Village shall be sold directly to a salvage yard.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: Pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the President and Board of Trustees find the following described property:

now owned by the Village of Lombard is no longer necessary or useful to the Village of Lombard and the best interests of the Village of Lombard will be served by its sale.

Section 2: Pursuant to said 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the Village President and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to sell the aforementioned personal property now owned by the Village of Lombard, at public auction, by Obenauf Auction Service to the highest bidder on said property. Vehicles valued less than the cost of auction fees and would not result in a net profit for the Village shall be sold directly to a salvage yard.

Section 3: The Village Manager is hereby authorized and may direct Obenauf Auction Service to advertise the sale of the aforementioned personal property in a newspaper published within the community before the date of said public auction.

Section 4: No bid which is less than the minimum price set forth in the list of property to be sold shall be accepted.

Section 5: The Village Manager or his designee shall cause to be transferred any titles or other legal documents pursuant to the sale.

Section 6: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval as provided by law.
