## **BACKGROUND/POLICY IMPLICATIONS:**

FISCAL IMPACT:

Attached is an ordinance to rebate and close out Special Service Area Number Seven. The special service area was originally established to provide special municipal services to 300 West 22<sup>nd</sup> Street in addition to services provided to the Village generally. Included in said services is the funding of the Village's cost of providing emergency medical services to the residents of Special Service Area 7, at a call rate per residential unit above and beyond the call rate normally associated with high-density multifamily residential housing developments. In order to pay these costs, the Board of Trustees approved Ordinance No. 6859 that established the 2014 levy for Special Service Area Number 7.

Based on the calculation provided in the Ordinance 6859, the call rate per residential unit above and beyond the call rate normally associated with high-density multi-family residential housing developments has not been significant enough to request an annual levy for 2015, 2016, and 2017.

Staff recommends the Village Board of Trustees approve the attached ordinance to rebate and close out Special Service Area Number Seven.
