This agreement is made this $\underline{6^{th}}$ day of <u>April</u>, 2017, between and shall be binding upon the Village of Lombard, an Illinois municipal corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "Village") and Alliance Contractors, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor") and their respective successors.

Witnessed, that in consideration of the mutual promises of the parties delineated in the Contract Documents, the Contractor agrees to perform the services and the Village agrees to pay for the following services as set forth in the Contract Documents:

The improvements include curb and gutter removal, sidewalk removal, new drainage structures with connections to the existing storm sewer system, new curb and gutter, PCC pavement widening, new concrete sidewalk, moving existing light poles and replacing associated wiring, removing and replacing PCC driveway aprons, modernizing existing traffic signals at the Roosevelt Road (Illinois Route 38)/Finley Road intersection, constructing new traffic signals at the Roosevelt Road (Illinois Route 38)/Mariano's Main Entrance intersection, traffic signal electrical service, interconnecting traffic signals, traffic control and protection, erosion control, removing and replacing pavement markings and reflective pavement markers, removal, storage, and erection of existing signage and new signage, landscape restoration, and all appurtenant items necessary for the completion of the work.

All of the above as well as other project details are further described in the contract documents for the said work prepared for the Village of Lombard by Christopher B. Burke Engineering, Ltd.

- 1. This contract shall embrace and include all of the applicable Contract Documents listed below as if attached hereto or repeated herein:
 - a. Contract Document Number ST-17-05/06 for Roosevelt Rd/Finley Rd Intersection Improvements, consisting of the following:

 - ii) Table of Contents
 - iii) Notice to Bidders Legal Notice
 - iv) General Provisions

 - vi) Plans and Specifications
 - b. The Contractor's Bid Proposal Dated: March 27, 2017
 - c. Required Performance and Payment Bonds and Certificate(s) of Insurance
 - d. Executed Bidder's Certification Form.



2. The Village agrees to pay, and the Contractor agrees to accept as full payment the amount as shown on the Contractor's Bid Proposal, which is made a part hereof, subject to such additions and deletions as agreed to by the parties hereto.

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- 3. The Contractor shall commence work under this Contract upon written Notice to Proceed from the Village and shall complete work under this contract within 141 calendar days from the date of the Notice to Proceed. Time is of the essence in regard to this Contract, and the Contractor agrees to achieve completion within the time permitted by all proper and appropriate means including working overtime without additional compensation.
- 4. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 5 of the Mechanics' Lien Act of Illinois, prior to making any payment to the Contractor under this Contract, the Village demands that the Contractor furnish a written statement of the names of all parties furnishing labor and/or materials under this Contract and the amounts due or to become due each. This statement must be made under oath or be verified by affidavit. The Village shall not issue final payment nor shall any retained percentage become due until releases and waivers of lien have been supplied as the Village designates.
- 5. This Contract represents the entire agreement between the parties and may not be modified without the written approval of both parties.
