FY 2018 Vehicle Replacement, C-Max Hybrid

Included in the FY2018 budget is the replacement of a Public Works Sewer Division 2010 Toyota Prius (unit # SM406 with 98,864 miles). This vehicle is a pool car and used for on-call personnel. Since this vehicle will be subject to higher usage, another hybrid vehicle is a cost effective replacement. Staff would like to replace the Toyota Prius with a Ford C-Max Hybrid. The C-Max is similar to the Prius however since most of the vehicles in the Village Fleet are Fords staff would gain some efficiency by having uniformity.

The Ford C-Max Hybrid is available for joint purchase through the State of Illinois (contract # 4018223). The current contract winner for this vehicle is Landmark Ford of Springfield (IL). The cost of the C-Max is \$22,142. The budgeted amount for this purchase is \$22,200.

I recommend the Board of Trustees award a contract to Landmark Ford of Springfield (IL) in the amount of \$22,142 for a new Ford C-Max Hybrid. I also recommend declaring Village unit number SM406 as surplus per the attached ordinance and authorize its sale at public auction. Waiver of first reading is requested on this ordinance. Please submit this item to the Village Board for their consideration at the December 7, 2017 meeting.

ORDINANCE	
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AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE BY PUBLIC AUCTION OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard, it is no longer necessary or useful to or in the best interest for the Village of Lombard to retain ownership of the personal property hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard to sell said personal property at public auction to be held by Obenauf Auction Service. Vehicles valued less than the cost of auction fees and would not result in a net profit for the Village shall be sold directly to a salvage yard.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: Pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the President and Board of Trustees find the following described property:

now owned by the Village of Lombard is no longer necessary or useful to the Village of Lombard and the best interests of the Village of Lombard will be served by its sale.

- Section 2: Pursuant to said 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the Village President and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to sell the aforementioned personal property now owned by the Village of Lombard, at public auction, by Obenauf Auction Service to the highest bidder on said property. Vehicles valued less than the cost of auction fees and would not result in a net profit for the Village shall be sold directly to a salvage yard.
- Section 3: The Village Manager is hereby authorized and may direct Obenauf Auction Service to advertise the sale of the aforementioned personal property in a newspaper published within the community before the date of said public auction.
- Section 4: No bid which is less than the minimum price set forth in the list of property to be sold shall be accepted.
- Section 5: The Village Manager or his designee shall cause to be transferred any titles or other legal documents pursuant to the sale.

Section 6: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval as provided by law.
