SUBJECT: Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A) of the Lombard Village Code
Alcoholic Beverages

In accordance with Village Code, liquor licenses are renewed on a semi-annual basis. Village staff just completed the renewal process for the December 1, 2017 through May 31, 2018 licensing term. As a result, W Wine LLC d/b/a The Cellar (Class "L-I") and Wineski's, Inc. d/b/a Wineski's, Inc. (Class "FF") voluntarily chose not to renew their liquor licenses and as of December 1, 2017 do not hold a valid liquor license. Attached is an ordinance decreasing their respective liquor license classifications ("L-I" and "FF" respectively) by one to account for their non-renewal.

Staff is requesting a waiver of first reading in order bring the number of entries in each liquor classification current.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112,
SECTION 112.13(A) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE TO REDUCE THE
NUMBER OF AVAILABLE LIQUOR LICENSES IN THE CLASS "L-I AND "FF"
LIQUOR LICENSE CATEGORIES**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF
THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS** as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class "L-I" liquor licenses, contained therein, to read as follows:

Class "L-I" – 0

SECTION 2: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class "FF" liquor licenses, contained therein, to read as follows:

Class "FF" – 1

SECTION 3: That the change in the number of Class "L-I" liquor licenses as set forth in Section 1 above is as a result of W Wine LLC d/b/a The Cellar located at 141 W. St. Charles Road and the change in the number of Class "FF" liquor licenses as set forth in Section 2 above is a result of Wineski's Inc. d/b/a Wineski's Inc. located at 854 N. Ridge Avenue voluntarily not renewing their liquor licenses for the license term beginning on December 1, 2017.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
