**SUBJECT: Amending Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A) of the Lombard Village Code
Residence Inn Chicago Lombard – 2001 S. Highland Avenue**

Interstate Management Company LLC d/b/a Residence Inn Chicago Lombard located at 2001 S. Highland Avenue currently holds a Class "T-I" liquor license. This classification allows beer and wine only served at no charge for consumption by patrons of the hotel (manager's reception) on the premises of a hotel without a restaurant along with the packaged sale of beer and wine only to patrons of the hotel.

As a result of a closing on September 26, 2017, new ownership took over and the current liquor license holder, Interstate Management Company LLC d/b/a Residence Inn Chicago Lombard no longer operates the hotel. Consequently, the liquor license issued to Interstate Interstate Management Company LLC d/b/a Residence Inn Chicago Lombard is no longer valid.

Attached is an ordinance decreasing the number of Class "T-I" licenses by one to reflect this change.

Staff is requesting a waiver of first reading to bring the number of licenses in this liquor classification current.

ORDINANCE _____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112,
SECTION 112.13(A) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN
REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS as follows:

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class "T-I" liquor license category, contained therein, to read as follows:

Class "T-I" – 0

Section 2: This decrease in the number of Class "T-I" liquor licenses reflects the ceasing of business by Interstate Management Company LLC d/b/a Residence Inn Chicago Lombard, located at 2001 S. Highland Avenue, Lombard, Illinois, and the termination of the Class "T-I" liquor license issued to Interstate Management Company LLC in relation thereto.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
