## **Technology Drive Parking Restriction**

The Public Safety and Transportation Committee reviewed a Village staff request for a parking restriction within the Technology Drive cul-de-sac. The Committee reviewed the request at the February Public Safety and Transportation public meeting.

Public Works staff has encountered difficulties during snow plow operations with parked vehicles within the court. DuPage Medical Group constructed additional off-street parking east of the cul-de-sac, but the cul-de-sac remains closer than that parking. That parking lot had no vehicles within it during a field site visit. Additionally, the facility is a surgical medical center, so EMS vehicles should have clear access to the facility driveways. The proposed restriction is a no parking restriction within the Technology Drive cul-de-sac.

During the February 5, 2018 meeting, the Public Safety and Transportation Committee voted to recommend the parking restriction in accordance with staff recommendation.

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Public Safety and Transportation Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Public Safety and Transportation Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Schedule VII, paragraph I entitled "PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS" of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) is amended to the following restriction:

"Technology Drive Both Sides": "Cul-de-sac Only" Remove "650 feet west"
